Members of Madison and the greater Dane County community will come together Saturday, April 16th for the 21st Take Back the Night March and Rally against sexual violence, organized by the Dane County Take Back the Night Coalition. The rally will begin at 7PM on the steps of the Capital and will feature music, poetry, survivor speakers, local service providers, and community leaders. The Lt. Governor of Wisconsin, Barbara Lawton, a lifelong activist for citizen rights will give this year's keynote address. After the rally, which is expected to last 1 hour, attendees will march through the streets of Madison with voices raised in an act of solidarity to protest sexual victimization in all forms. The March will conclude with a candlelight vigil and a survivor speakout where women, whose lives have been forever changed by violence, are invited and encouraged to share their experiences in a supportive and empowering space.
